It was a childhood dream of Ali's to own a farm and grow fresh, local food. Aliabaad Farm was established on May 7, 2007 and is expanding to meet the local demand for their organic produce. Ali grows a wide variety of vegetables, fruit, and herbs including: eggplant, zucchini, peppers, butternut squash, corn, tomatoes, cucumbers, cantaloupe, watermelon, lettuce, spinach, basil, dill, and many more.

Aliabaad Farm is also home to goats and free range chickens. The farm has a crop share program which runs 24-27 weeks a year and delivers produce and organic eggs to Montgomery and Washington Counties. They also sell their produce to Wholefoods, Yekta, and Yass supermarkets and directly to the public at their farm stand.

Ali is a committed steward of the land and has implemented many best management practices on Aliabaad Farm including 1.2 acres of conservation crop rotation and 2.2 acres of cover crop. The farm also features 100 feet of pasture fencing and a high tunnel.
