Moore or Less Farm



Jim “Moe” Moore and his wife Elissa own and operate Moore or Less Farm in Bushwood. This 65 acre farm is on the same road as the Historic St. Clement’s Island State Park. Moe has been farming his entire life and his family grew tobacco for three generations dating back to the late 1800’s. Moore or Less Farm was a tobacco operation until 2005 when they converted their fields to hay and pasture for their livestock. The Moore’s grow their own vegetables and raise award winning alpacas. The old tobacco barn has been converted into a farm market where they sell products from their own farm and also support other local growers. They also grow Christmas trees and are developing “pick your own” raspberry and blackberry patches.

The Moore’s have implemented many conservation practices on their farm including 2.8 acres of conservation cove crop rotation, grassed waterways, over 800 feet of diversion, 1,950 feet of streamline fencing, an acre of heavy use area protection and a watering facility.
